

DR. RON ZOKOL

Soft Tissue and Bone Procedures to Enhance Implant Health, Esthetics and Longevity

It is a rare implant case that presents without some need of



bone augmentation and/or soft tissue refinement. This presentation will discuss different treatment options for different case types. It will also address advanced procedures in bone grafting to show what is possible and the salient principles which makes them successful and predictable.

Dr. Ron Zokol is a Past President of the Vancouver and District Dental Society and recipient of VDDS' Paul Rondeau Memorial Humanitarian Award. Dr. Zokol graduated in 1974 from the University of British Columbia's Faculty of Dentistry, where he continues as a sessional Lecturer to the Graduate Prosthodontic students and as a member of the Dean's Board of Councillors. He is also a member of the External Advisory Board for the Department of Bioengineering at the University of Maine. He holds fellowships in the American Academy of Implant Dentistry, the American College of Dentists and the Canadian Academy of Restorative Dentistry and Prosthodontics. He is a Diplomate of the American Board of Oral Implantology/Implant Dentistry and the International Congress of Oral Implantologists. He has served as Chair of the General Examination Committee and Chief Examiner for the College of Dental Surgeons of BC board examinations. He was a surgical instructor for the Misch Implant Institute for 10 years and has lectured locally and internationally for more than 25 years in prosthodontics and surgery. In private practice since graduation, Dr. Zokol founded the Pacific Institute for Advanced Dental Education in 1996 and now practices at BC Perio in Vancouver providing services in advanced surgical and prosthetic rehabilitation.

Endodontics: What's Necessary!

Dr. Earl Winestock attended the University of Manitoba dental school and graduated in 1969 with his D.M.D degree.

Dr. Winestock received his graduate degree in Endodontics from the University of Oregon Health Science Center and started the Evergreen EndoGroup in Coquitlam.

Dr. Winestock has performed more than 25,000 endodontic procedures in all aspects of his specialty. The EndoGroup were the leaders in using digital radiography and microscopes in Vancouver. He is a past president and current member of both the BC Society



of Endodontics and the Canadian Academy of Endodontics. He is a member of the American Association of Endodontics and the International Federation of Endodontists. Dr. Winestock holds the position of clinical associate professor as part-time clinical instructor and lecturer at the UBC school of dentistry.

Dr. Samson Ng is a Canadian and American Board Certified Oral Medicine Specialist and Oral and Maxillofacial Pathologist. He is currently appointed as Clinical Associate Professor at the University of British Columbia, attending staff at the Department of Dentistry of the Vancouver General Hospital, and the Program of Oral Oncology/Dentistry in the BC Cancer Agency and pathology consultant. Dr. Ng also operates a private practice which provides comprehensive oral



medicine and pathology consultations, with a special interest in oral mucosal and temporomandibular joint diseases.

She has pioneered a research project at Children's hospital to improve access of care and dental experience for patients with autism and her research was recently published in the Journal of Clinical Pediatric Dentistry.


