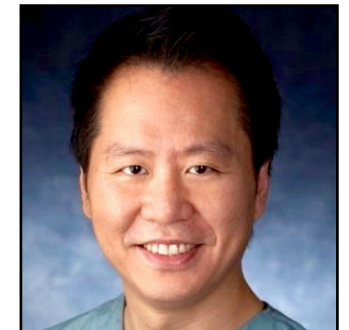

**DR. RON ZOKOL****Bone and Soft Tissue Surgical Procedures  
For Prosthetic Excellence**

We are occasionally faced with complicated clinical conditions that make high quality, esthetic solution for Implant Dentistry almost impossible. We will discuss some of these case types and offer solutions to these difficult challenges. Advanced bone grafting and soft tissue grafting will be discussed as will recent advances in precision surgical accuracy for implant placement. Single tooth solutions along with full arch surgical prosthetic solutions will be discussed. Open conversation will be invited.



**Dr. Ron Zokol** is a Past President of the Vancouver and District Dental Society and recipient of VDDS' prestigious Paul Rondeau Memorial Humanitarian Award. Dr. Zokol graduated in 1974 from the University of British Columbia's Faculty of Dentistry, where he continues as a sessional Lecturer to the Graduate Prosthodontic students and as a member of the Dean's Board of Councillors. He is also a member of the External Advisory Board for the Department of Bioengineering at the University of Maine. He holds fellowships in the American Academy of Implant Dentistry, the American College of Dentists and the Canadian Academy of Restorative Dentistry and Prosthodontics. He is a Diplomate of the American Board of Oral Implantology/Implant Dentistry and the International Congress of Oral Implantologists. He has served as Chair of the General Examination Committee and Chief Examiner for the College of Dental Surgeons of BC board examinations. He was a surgical instructor for the Misch Implant Institute for 10 years and has lectured locally and internationally for more than 25 years in prosthodontics and surgery. In private practice since graduation, he founded the Pacific Institute for Advanced Dental Education in 1996 and now practices at BC Perio in Vancouver providing services in advanced surgical and prosthetic rehabilitation.

**DR. ANITA GARTNER****Treatment Planning in Pediatric Dentistry:  
Tools and Tips!**

Dental Practitioners know that one size does not fit all - it is important to individualize your treatment plans to match your patient. In Pediatric Dentistry, you also have to understand that you don't just treat the patient; you need to address the needs of the family. In order to do this we need to build relationships with the patient and family and have more than one tool in our box to offer options to our families. These tools will be presented in this session as we discuss: 1) Nuances of the Pediatric

Patient and Parent; 2) Behaviour Management; 3) Radiographs; 4) Prevention; 5) Restorative Materials and Techniques; and 6) Nitrous Oxide Sedation.

**Dr. Anita Gartner** is a Past President of the Vancouver and District Dental Society. A Certified Specialist in Pediatric Dentistry, Dr. Gartner is a Fellow of the Royal College of Dentists of Canada and a Diplomate of the American Board of Pediatric Dentistry. She has volunteered on professional boards in the Evergreen Pediatric Dental Study Club (Seattle, WA), B.C. Pediatric Dentist Society and the Audit Committee of B.C. Children's Hospital. She has participated in joint clinical studies with graduate students and post doctoral students from the Department of Oral Health and Psychology at the University of British Columbia and Public Health at the University of Washington. Her interests include dental technologies, child development and empowerment, and how to reduce a child's pain and anxiety. Dr. Gartner was appointed as Assistant Clinical Professor to assist with the development of the Graduate Pediatric Dental Program at UBC.

Endodontic treatment can, at times, be fraught with difficulties. Using a case-based approach, Dr. Lin would like to share with you some of the cases he has encountered in his clinical practice and he hopes to enlighten the audience on how those teeth can be saved for the benefit of our patients using contemporary advanced endodontic treatment modalities, techniques and materials.



While growing up, **Dr. James Lin** always wanted to pursue a career in the health care profession and was accepted into both medical and dental schools at the University of Toronto. He decided to follow his dream of practicing dentistry by obtaining his dental degree with top honours from the Faculty of Dentistry, University of Toronto. Dr. Lin worked as a general dentist for 12 years before returning to school to complete his Graduate Specialty Training in Endodontics and MSc degree in Craniofacial Science at the Faculty of Dentistry, University of British Columbia. Upon graduation and passing the Board exam, he was conferred as a Fellow of the Royal College of Dentists of Canada. A Certified Specialist in Endodontics, Dr. Lin has been involved in endodontic teaching and research at UBC and has been the recipient of numerous academic and teaching awards. Published in numerous peer-reviewed scientific journals, he has also co-authored chapters in two distinguished endodontic textbooks. Currently, Dr. Lin is an Associate Clinical Professor and the Director of Endodontics for the DMD Program at UBC (sabbatical). He maintains a private endodontic specialty practice in Vancouver.
